



## NW street safety promise

THE Tasmanian Liberals have promised to improve safety in Tasmania's North-West by increasing police numbers and installing new CC-TV cameras in Devonport.

Liberal leader Will Hodgman said the package of election promises would make Devonport's streets safer.

"Sadly, Devonport's streets are becoming increasingly unsafe after

dark — examples of this are recent YouTube footage of a violent brawl and the alleged assault of two French backpackers last Saturday night," Mr Hodgman said.

He said six of 30 new police officers promised by the Liberals would be appointed to the Western District.

And \$200,000 would be spent on four new surveillance cameras.
